CONSERVATOR EDUCATION CLASSES

The Probate Department of San Francisco Superior Court offers Conservator Education Classes for conservators who are family and friends and those who have filed documents seeking to be appointed as conservator. Private professional conservators provide the classes free of charge. Attendance is required in person or via Zoom video conference. The classes are held in the Probate Courtroom, Civic Center Courthouse, Room 204. Advance registration is required by emailing sfcourtclass@gmail.com. Please email/bring a copy of the Letters of Conservatorship issued to you when you attend class.

Conservator of person and conservator of estate classes are taught on the same day. Participants who are appointed conservator of both person and estate may complete the classes in one day or on different days. Please allow extra time to enter the courthouse due to social distancing guidelines and wear a mask. You may be requested to show the email confirmation of your class registration to court staff as you enter the courthouse. Social distancing protocols will be strictly observed at all times.

Classes must be completed within six (6) months of being appointed conservator, excluding the 90 days considered as legal holidays in accordance to the court emergency rules related to the COVID-19 pandemic.

The court has canceled the class on June 5th, 2020.
