


THE JUDICIAL COUNCIL OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

Because of the COVID-19 pandemic, and the proclamations of states of emergency by Governor Gavin Newsom and President Donald Trump, it has been determined that the conditions described in section 68115 of the Government Code are met with regard to the Superior Court of California, County of San Francisco (Court). On March 16, 2020, an Order issued at the request of Presiding Judge Garrett L. Wong authorizing the Court to implement various forms of relief authorized by section 68115. This Order supplements that March 16, 2020, Order.

It is hereby ordered that the Superior Court of San Francisco County is authorized to do the following:

- Declare that from March 18, 2020, to April 15, 2020, inclusive, be deemed holidays for purposes of computing the time for filing papers with the Court under Code of Civil Procedure sections 12 and 12a. (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(4).)
